Total Summary since 2014:

Completed 4th systematic pass of entire 30 acre site in June of 2021, however future restoration efforts will focus on 3 most promising portions of the site due to extent of deterioration and loss largely caused by ROD and minimal operating budget. Focus now on core ha'iwale area (6-7 acres), Central Volunteer area (3-4 acres), and west side area (4-5). This means efforts cover app.15 acres which we still hope to fence in against feral pig activity.
