

Restoration Out-planting Species for Keau'ohana

Common restoration species in order of abundance:

Mamaki (*Pipturus albidus*) (direct seeding)
Ohe (*Polyscias hawaiensis*)
Hapu'u (*Cibotium*)
Kopiko (*Psychotria hawaiiensis*)
'Ohi'a (*Metrosideros polymorpha*)
Kolea (*Myrsine lessertiana*)
Loulu (*Pritchardia beccariana*)
Lama (*Diospyros sandwicensis*)
Ha'iwale (*Cyrtandra Nanawalensis*)
Akia (*Wikstroemia sandwicensis*)
Alahe'e (*Psydrax odarata*)
Hala (*Pandanus tectorius*)- in more disturbed pockets

Other species in smaller numbers (experimental):

Clermontia hawaiiensis (Oha kepau) -- Not successful
Hame (*Antidesma platyphyllum*)
Kou (*Cordia subcordata*)
Maile (*Alyxia stellata*)
Ma'o hau hele, Hau Hele (*Hibiscus spp.*)
'Opuhe (*Urera glabra*)
Papala kepau (*Pisonia umbellifera*)
